Interstate 5 South Corridor Improvement Projects

I-5 South Corridor - FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES

A Series of Brief, Intermittent Nightly Closures between Valley View and Rosecrans

La Mirada, Norwalk, Santa Fe Springs – Caltrans will conduct a series of brief and intermittent, FULL FREEWAY closures in the early morning hours on the northbound and southbound Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) between Valley View Avenue and Rosecrans Avenue for two nights **Monday and Tuesday, October 29 and 30, from midnight to 4 am.**

California Highway Patrol (CHP) will conduct traffic breaks for the FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES. Each closure – three or four per night in each direction – will last approximately 7 to 10 minutes at hourly intervals.

- **Northbound I-5:** CHP will intermittently close and hold traffic at the NB I-5 on-ramp at Valley View and, if possible, CHP will direct motorists towards the option to exit at Valley View Ave. **Closed Ramp:** NB I-5 on-ramp at Alondra Blvd. will be fully closed.
- **Southbound I-5:** CHP will intermittently close and hold traffic at the SB I-5 on-ramp at Rosecrans and, if possible, CHP will direct motorists towards the option to exit at Rosecrans Ave.

The work involves relocating utility lines across the freeway. Southern California Edison will perform the work as part of the I-5 South Corridor Improvement Projects. Due to the nature of this work, the closures are weather-permitting and are subject to change or cancellation.

In other work,

Nightly, Wed. October 31, Thurs. November 1 and Fri. November 2 from 7 pm to 5 am

Southbound I-5: Caltrans will **FULLY CLOSE** the SB I-5 off-ramp at Carmenita Road. The SB I-5 on-ramp at Carmenita Road remains **OPEN**.

Street Closure: **FULL CLOSURE** of Carmenita Place, a short street abutting Carmenita Rd.

The I-5 South Corridor Improvement Projects will construct one carpool and one general purpose lane in each direction, realign and upgrade adjacent frontage roads, and reconstruct bridges from the Los Angeles/Orange County line to Interstate 605.
