GOLDEN STATE FREEWAY (I-5) AT TEMPLIN HIGHWAY – STORM-RELATED PAVEMENT DAMAGE CLOSES ONE SOUTHBOUND LANE TODAY

North Los Angeles County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that one lane of the southbound Golden State Freeway (I-5) at Templin Highway will be closed this afternoon -- at approximately 3 p.m. -- in order to perform additional striping and repairs due to storm-related pavement damage. Templin Highway is located approximately five miles north of Castaic along the southern portion of the Grapevine.

Due to impending rain in the weather forecast, this lane closure may last for the remainder of the week.

No travel delays are expected. Three southbound lanes and three northbound lanes of I-5 will remain open to motorists.

This closure is weather-permitting and subject to change. Caltrans thanks motorists for their patience and cooperation during these storm-related roadway repairs.
