CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Monday, November 13 and Tuesday November 14:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from westbound I-10 connector to SR-60/ U.S. 101 interchange

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Wednesday, Night, November 15:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from westbound I-10 connector to 4th Street
- 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Cesar Chavez Boulevard on-ramp
- 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes from Glendale Boulevard to SR-2 connector
- 8:30 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Glendale Avenue on- and off-ramps

Thursday, Night, November 16:

- 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. – westbound I-10 to the southbound I-5
- 8:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Mission Road on-ramp
- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from I-5 to SR-2 connector

Nightly, Thursday, November 16 and Friday, November 17:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 4 lanes from I-10 to Cesar Chavez Boulevard
- 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fletcher Drive off-ramp
- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Stadium Way off-ramp

Friday, Night, November 17:

- 9 p.m. until 8:30 a.m. – Cesar Chavez Boulevard on-ramp
- 10 a.m. until 8 a.m. – 4th Street off-ramp

Saturday, Night, November 18:

- 9 p.m. until 10 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from eastbound I-10 to Cesar Chavez Boulevard

Nightly, Friday, November 17 and Saturday, November 18:

- 8:30 p.m. until 9:30 a.m. – Mission Road on-ramp
- 8:30 p.m. until 9:30 a.m. – Broadway Boulevard on-ramp
- 9 p.m. until 10 a.m. – southbound I-5 to I-10 eastbound connector

Westbound I-10

Nightly, Friday, November 17 and Saturday, November 18:

- 9 p.m. until 10 a.m. – southbound I-10 to the southbound I-5 connector

Closures are weather permitting and subject to change. FCI Constructors Inc. is the contractor for this \$ 44 million project. The project will replace damaged pavement and upon completion, will provide a smoother riding surface and extend the life span of the road. Estimated project completion is fall 2008.
