## CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

### Northbound I-5

#### Nightly, Friday December 1 through Saturday, December 9:

- 8:30 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. – Marengo Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. – North Broadway off-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 8:30 a.m. – Main Street off-ramp

#### Sunday, Night, December 3:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to two lanes from State Street to SR-110
- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – one lane from I-10 connector to SR-110
- 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – State Street on-ramp

#### Wednesday, Night, December 6:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from the I-10 to North Broadway
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – westbound I-10 connector to I-5 connector

### Southbound I-5

#### Monday, Night, December 4:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to two lanes from North Broadway to I-10

#### Tuesday, Night, December 5:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to two lanes from SR-110 to Figueroa Street

### **Wednesday, Night, December 6:**

- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – southbound I-5 to I-10/SR-60 interchange
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – southbound I-5 connector to eastbound I-10
- 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 4<sup>th</sup> Street on-off ramps
- 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Cesar Chaves Avenue on-ramp

### **Nightly, Thursday, December 7 and Saturday, December 9:**

- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to four lanes from I-10 Connector to Cesar Chavez Boulevard

### **Westbound I-10**

### **Nightly, Friday, December 1 through Saturday, December 9:**

- 9 p.m. to 8 a.m. – westbound I-10 connector to southbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56.783 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
