CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Friday, Night, October 27:

11:59 until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes closed from 4th Street to Whittier Boulevard

Nightly, Sunday, October 29 through Wednesday, November 1:

- 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes closed I-5 connector to SR-60/I-10 interchange

Nightly, Wednesday, November 1 and Thursday, November 2:

- 11:59 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes closed from Stadium Way to SR-110 connector

Nightly, Thursday, November 2 and Friday, November 3:

- 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes closed from I-10 connector to 4th Street

Nightly, Thursday, November 2 and Friday, November 3:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Mission Road on-ramp
- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Cesar Chavez Avenue on-ramp

Friday, Night, November 3:

- 10 p.m. until 8 a.m. – up to 3 lanes closed from I-10 connector to 4th Street
- 10 p.m. until 8 a.m. – westbound I-10 connector to the southbound I-5 connector

Saturday, Night, November 4:

- 1 a.m. until 10 a.m. – up to 3 lanes closed from SR-2 connector to SR-110 connector
- 1 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. – Glendale Boulevard on-ramp
- 1 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. – Stadium Way on-ramp

SOUTHBOUND SR-2

Wednesday, Night, November 1:

- 1 a.m. until 4 a.m. – one lane closed from SR-2 connector to Stadium Way

NORTH- AND SOUTHBOUND SR-2

Friday, Night, November 3 and Saturday, Night, November 4:

- 10 p.m. until 10 a.m. – northbound SR-2 connector to southbound I-5

WESTBOUND I-10

Friday, Night, November 3:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – westbound I-10 connector to the southbound I-5

Closures are weather permitting and subject to change. FCI Constructors Inc. is the contractor for this \$ 44 million project. The project will replace damaged pavement and upon completion, will provide a smoother riding surface and extend the life span of the road. Estimated project completion is fall 2008.
