INFORMATIONAL NOTICE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin resurfacing the existing pavement with a new layer of rubberized asphalt on SR-23 between Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) and Westlake Village City limits.

The closures are estimated to begin Monday, March 26, 2007, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. and will continue Mondays through Fridays, lasting approximately four weeks. Closures are weather permitting and subject to change.

It will be necessary to either completely close or partially close SR-23 at various locations while pavement work is being performed. A portable Changeable Message Sign (CMS) will be placed at either the end of the project limits notifying the public of construction and the subsequent delays.

A signed detour will be posted as necessary for motorists assistance.

Sully-Miller Contracting Company is the contractor on this \$3.1 million project that will provide a smoother and safer ride on this canyon route.
