## Improvement Work on Western Avenue (SR-213)

**Los Angeles** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will make the following improvements on Western Avenue:

- Reconfigure the east- and westbound left-turn pockets for traffic turning from Westmont and Delasonde Drive onto Western Avenue.
- Modify existing signal phasing.
- Re-construct curbs to meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990.
- Install loop detectors.
- Re-stripe using thermoplastic paint

This project will improve overall traffic operations, ease left-turn movements onto Western Avenue as well as improving efficiency and pedestrian accessibility. These upgrades will improve safety and meet current Caltrans standards.

The project will start in December 1<sup>st</sup> and continue through early February 2015. Construction will take place daily, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., excluding weekends and holidays. Intermittent closures may include the intersection and one lane in both directions. Accessibility for motorists will be maintained at all times.

Local businesses, motorists and residents may experience traffic delays, noise and minimal vibrations from construction activities. Caltrans appreciates your patience while we work to improve Western Avenue. The contractor for this \$195,000 project is Traffic Development Systems Inc, of Moorpark, California.
