Community Update **Pacific Coast Highway** **Pavement Project Update** **New Work Hours**

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is continuing pavement replacement on Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) at various locations along a three-mile stretch from Robert Road to Catalina Avenue in the cities of Torrance and Redondo Beach.

Construction activities are scheduled daily Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Intermittent lane closures will be limited to one lane in each direction. Motorists are advised to expect delays during construction hours. When necessary, "TEMPORARY NO PARKING" signs will be posted. Temporary no parking during construction hours only.

Significant noise and traffic delays can be anticipated during this phase of the project. The adjustment of manholes and water valves, installation of road sensors and road striping will be performed.

This project will provide a new and smoother driving surface, leading to a reduction of the need for future maintenance. Caltrans appreciates your cooperation and understanding while we work to improve Pacific Coast Highway.

Work is expected to complete September 2007.
