# **NORTHBOUND PASADENA FREEWAY (SR-110) -- SINKHOLE REPAIRED; LANES TO OPEN BETWEEN 5:30 AND 6 P.M.**

**SOUTH PASADENA** – The northbound Pasadena Freeway (SR-110) at Fair Oaks Avenue is expected to re-open today between 5:30 and 6 p.m. after the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) repaired a sinkhole that was discovered yesterday at about 6 p.m.

The sinkhole was caused by corrosion of a 30-inch diameter underground water drainage pipe. Caltrans crews replaced a 26-foot piece of underground pipe and re-paved the roadway.

The cost of these repairs are estimated at \$170,000.

Caltrans thanks the motoring public for the patience and understanding during these roadway repairs.
