Long Beach Freeway (I-710) Lane Closures for Construction Project

LONG BEACH - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the north- and southbound Long Beach Freeway (I-710) for pavement replacement and to replace the metal beam center median with concrete barriers from Ocean Boulevard to Pacific Coast Highway (PCH)/State Route 1 (SR-1).

The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Tuesday night, May 1 through Friday, May 4:

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. - up to three lanes of northbound I-710 from W. Shoreline Drive to PCH (SR-1).
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. - up to two lanes southbound I-710 from PCH (SR- 1) to W. Shoreline Drive.
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – northbound I-710 on-ramp from W. Shoreline Drive.
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – southbound I-710 off-ramp to W. Shoreline Drive.

Overnight, Friday, May 4:

- 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. - up to two lanes of southbound I-710 from PCH (SR-1) to W. Shoreline Drive.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. - southbound I-710 off-ramp to W. Shoreline Drive.
- 7 p.m. to 9 a.m. - up to three lanes of northbound I-710 from W. Shoreline Drive to PCH (SR-1).
- 1 a.m. to 8 a.m. - northbound I-710 on-ramp from W. Shoreline Drive.

All American Asphalt is the contractor of this \$5.6 million project that is estimated to complete in fall of 2008. The benefits of this re-pavement project are a smoother driving surface and an extended life span of the road.

For the safety of work crews on the freeway, Caltrans reminds the public to please **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
