**Nightly Closures on Foothill Freeway (I-210)**

*Los Angeles County* — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close various lanes of the Foothill Freeway (I-210) in multiply locations, between Pasadena and La Verne for resurfacing nightly, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Closure will be in both directions, on- and off-ramps will be closed as required and consecutive ramp closures will be necessary. One lane will remain open at all times.

This 22-mile project will resurface or replace slabs, asphalt and new striping. Noise from demolition and grinding is anticipated.

The **\$48 million** project will improve the driving surface, reduce maintenance, enhance safety and provide a smoother commute. J. McLoughlin is the contractor on this is project expected to complete fall 2012.
