Caltrans to Host Two Public Workshops to Address SR-710 Surplus Property Regulations

LOS ANGELES — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 7 will host two Public Workshops in October to provide information and request public input on SR-710 property sales regulations. These regulations will implement existing law and SB 416, and establish procedures for the sale of SR-710 properties no longer deemed necessary for use by Caltrans.
