COMMUNITY MEETING PLANNED FOR US-101/SR-23 INTERCHANGE PROJECT

THOUSAND OAKS – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in conjunction with the city of Thousand Oaks, will hold a community meeting on **Wednesday, February 5**, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. to discuss the US-101/SR-23 Interchange Improvement Project.

Representatives from Caltrans and the city will be on hand to answer questions and discuss the work, general construction schedule and types of closures anticipated. Elements of the project include widening the freeway, reconstructing and adding lanes, constructing soundwalls and replacing pavement in order to ease congestion and reduce delays.

Security Paving is the contractor on the project, estimated to complete in spring 2016.
