## U.S. 101 CLOSURES SCHEDULED IN VENTURA COUNTY

**OXNARD** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) reports the following closures on the Ventura Freeway (U.S. 101) **nightly** from Tuesday, October 17 to Saturday, October 21:

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, October 17 through Friday, October 20, two lanes (of three) on northbound U.S. 101 from Vineyard Avenue to Johnson Drive and the Vineyard Avenue on-ramp to northbound U.S. 101
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, October 17 through Friday, October 20, two lanes (of three) on southbound U.S. 101 from Victoria Avenue to Wagon Wheel Road; the Victoria Avenue on-ramp to southbound U.S. 101 and the Johnson Drive on-ramp to southbound U.S. 101
- 6 a.m. to 12 p.m., Saturday, October 21, the Johnson Drive on-ramp to northbound U.S. 101

The closures are in relation to construction of the Oxnard Boulevard on-ramp to northbound U.S. 101, part of a \$100 million improvement project on U.S. 101 from Vineyard Avenue in Oxnard to Johnson Drive in Ventura. The project, which began in 2002, is expected to complete before the end of 2007. Major components include construction of a full diamond interchange at Oxnard Boulevard, the addition of northbound and southbound lanes to U.S. 101 and construction of a new bridge over the Santa Clara River.
