## CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR ROUTE 170

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close up to two lanes of southbound Hollywood Freeway (SR-170), for bridge widening in preparation for new sound wall construction. The closures are as follows:

**Nightly, Wednesday, July 5 through Thursday July 6:**

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Roscoe Boulevard to Sherman Way
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Eastbound and westbound Roscoe Boulevard on-ramps
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Westbound Roscoe Boulevard on-ramp

**Nightly, Thursday, July 6 through Saturday July 8:**

- 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Roscoe Boulevard to Sherman Way
- 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Eastbound and westbound Roscoe Boulevard on-ramps
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Westbound Roscoe Boulevard on-ramp

Closures are weather permitting and subject to change. Security Paving Company, Inc. is the contractor for this \$5 million project. The project is schedule for completion in summer 2007.
