Caltrans To Open Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1)

WHAT: A press conference to announce the opening of SR-1 between Sycamore Cove and Yerba Buena Road. All sections of the highway will be open for the motoring public by 3 p.m.

WHEN: Friday, February 27, 1 p.m.

WHERE: Just south of Sycamore Cove Beach on SR-1 (four miles north of Yerba Buena Road). Participants and the media should park on shoulder of northbound SR-1 within the closure.

Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) between Yerba Buena Road and Las Posas Road was closed after rain storms, debris slides, and high surf in December and January caused extensive damage along the highway in the Springs Fire Burn Area in Point Mugu State Park. Six-miles of the 9-mile closure between Las Posas Road and Sycamore Cove Day Use Area were opened to the public on February 3.
