Landslide Repairs Continue, Connector Roads Remain Closed

SAN DIMAS – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues to repair the damage caused by the landslide Thursday, February 18 along the westbound San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) and northbound Corona Freeway (SR-71) connector roads to the northbound Orange Freeway (SR-57). Caltrans expects to reopen the connector roads mid-April 2010.

To stabilize the hillside, the slopes have been graded along the connector roads to create three terraces, new drainage ditches have been built, and approximately 100,000 cubic yards of dirt have been removed.

Over the next several weeks repair crews will continue to remove dirt and debris from the roadway and culverts, maintain erosion control, repair the damaged roadway pavement, and restripe the connector roads.
