



**SR-2 remains closed from La Cañada Flintridge to Mt. Wilson Rd. It is estimated to reopen by late Nov. or early Dec. 2010.**

The Angeles Crest Highway sustained severe damage due to mudslides and debris flows caused by heavy rains in the Station Fire burn area in January 2010. Several sections of the highway were washed away by heavy rains, leaving the highway impassable and unsafe for the general public.

**Update - November 5, 2010**

**Post Mile 27.12**



Soldier piles, tie backs, along with other support structures will help to support the roadway above.

**Post Mile 28.24**



A concrete flume will be constructed at Browns Canyon to allow water and debris to flow down the hillside to a creek below. The flume will help to reduce erosion to the slope.

**Post Mile 34.55**



An 11-foot diameter culvert pipe had to be replaced due to erosion. The slope above is being rebuilt from the creek up to the original road level.

**Post Miles 35.42**



Soldier piles, tie backs, and other supporting structures will be constructed at this location to support the highway above.
