Western Avenue (SR-213) Repaving Project

SAN PEDRO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is repaving Western Avenue (SR-213) between 19th Street and Avenida Apprenda with rubberized asphalt (RA). This project began on Monday, October 8 and is expected to finish by mid-November 2012.

All paving between 19th Street and 1st Street is completed. Tonight the Contractor will pave between 1st and Capitol. Noise and vibrations are expected.

Closures:

This project will require the nightly closure of one lane of SR-213 in both directions between 25th Street and Avenida Apprenda. Work will take place Mondays through Fridays, between 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. the following mornings.

This is the expected schedule for the week of Monday, October 22:

- 10/22 Grinding between Capitol Dr. and Caddington Dr.
- 10/23 Grinding between Caddington Dr. and Delasonde Dr.
Paving between Capitol Dr. and Caddington Dr.
- 10/24 Grinding between Delasonde Dr. and Avenida Apprenda
Paving between Caddington Dr. and Delasonde Dr.
- 10/25 Paving between Delasonde Dr. and Avenida Apprenda.

Closures are subject to change. Weather and other unforeseen delays could affect construction work.

RA will help extend the life of the pavement, reduce maintenance costs, and provide for a smoother ride. All American Asphalt of Corona, Calif. is the contractor on this \$1.2 million project.
