EMERGENCY CLOSURE ON 7th STREET/ EASTBOUND SR-22/ SOUTHBOUND I-405 AND EASTBOUND SR-22 TO NORTHBOUND I-605/ I-405 CONNECTORS

Irvine- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) closed the 7th Street/ Eastbound SR-22 to the Northbound I-605 and I-405 freeway connectors, for an unknown duration due to a piece of machinery weighing more than 200 tons falling off a big rig causing damage to the road, guardrail and bridge.

All Eastbound traffic on 7th Street/ SR-22 is closed at Studebaker Road.

Detours and Electronic Changeable Message Signs are in place.

Recommended detour routes:

Motorist traveling to NB I-605, proceed North on Studebaker Road, turn right on Willow to access NB I-605.

Motorist traveling to SB I-405, proceed South on Studebaker, turn left on East 2nd Street/ Westminster Avenue, turn left on Seal Beach Boulevard or Bolsa Chica Road.
