

I-10 HOV (CARPOOL) LANE PROJECT FACT SHEET



The Project

Construction of one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane along the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) in each direction between Puente Avenue and Citrus Street in Baldwin Park and West Covina.

Summary Interstate 10 has experienced serious congestion while carrying a substantial amount of traffic. To address this issue, approximately 4.1 miles of carpool lanes will be built in each direction of I-10. This is the second of three projects that upon completion will offer one continuous HOV lane from downtown Los Angeles to I-15 in San Bernardino County.



Benefits

The I-10 HOV project will increase the 532 mile carpool lane system in Los Angeles County, add freeway capacity, reduce congestion by encouraging carpooling, improve traffic flow, and reduce energy consumption, thereby improving air quality. Soundwalls will be constructed to mitigate noise at various locations throughout the project boundaries and help improve the quality of life for residents.

Project Schedule

Construction for phase two began June, 2014 and has an estimated completion of spring, 2019.
