WHAT

Caltrans has scheduled overnight northbound and southbound US 101 lane closures to continue setting concrete barriers (k-rail).

WHERE

Northbound and southbound US 101 from Mobil Pier Road to Bates Road in Ventura County.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Northbound US 101 Overnight Lane Closures

Date: Wednesday, August 29 and Thursday, August 30

Hours: 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Closure: Northbound US 101 will have one lane closed from Mobil Pier Road to Bates Road. One lane will remain open at all times during the closure.

Southbound US 101 Overnight Lane Closures

Date: Wednesday, August 29 from 9 p.m. to 8 a.m.

Thursday, August 30 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Closure: Southbound US 101 will have one lane closed from Mobil Pier Road to Bates Road. One lane will remain open at all times during the closure.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project is constructing a six-mile carpool lane in each direction for vehicles with two or more passengers, along US 101 from Mobil Pier Road in Ventura County to Casitas Pass Road in Santa Barbara County.

Additional improvements include: a pedestrian undercrossing in La Conchita, concrete barriers, southbound bike lane, median landscaping, reconstruction of existing drainage, closing existing median openings and installing Intelligent Transportation Systems.

Construction began in 2012 and will end in 2015.
