## CLOSURE NOTICE

### WHAT

Caltrans has scheduled lane closures on the northbound and southbound US 101 between Mobil Pier Road and Bates Road to prepare for the shift in traffic lanes in Ventura County.

### WHERE

Northbound and southbound US 101 between  
Mobil Pier Road and Bates Road

### WHEN

Sunday, December 8 through Thursday, December 12, 2013

### WHAT TO EXPECT

#### Freeway Lane Shift:

The shift, estimated for implementation by the week of December 12, involves the northbound and southbound freeway lanes to be shifted to the center median (future newly paved carpool lane) to continue working on the outside lanes. Two lanes in each direction will remain open.

Motorists are encouraged to look ahead when approaching the shift in the lanes between Mobil Pier Road and Bates Road.

#### Lane Closures:

Sunday, December 8: One lane closed in each direction

\*Northbound US 101 from 9 pm to 6 am

\*Southbound US 101 from 9 pm to 9 am

Monday, December 9 to Thursday, December 12

One lane closed in each direction

\*Northbound US 101 from 7 pm to 6am

\*Southbound US 101 from 8 pm to 9 am

### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project is constructing a six-mile carpool lane in each direction along US 101 from Mobil Pier Road in Ventura County to Casitas Pass Road in Santa Barbara County.

Additional improvements include: a pedestrian undercrossing in La Conchita, concrete barriers, southbound bike lane, median landscaping, reconstruction of existing drainage, closing existing median openings and installing Intelligent Transportation Systems.
