What is Being Planned? *The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is currently studying the feasibility of replacing the Albion River and Salmon Creek Bridges, and realigning the roadway from 0.6 miles south of the Salmon Creek Bridge to 0.6 miles north of the Albion River Bridge on Route 1 in Mendocino County near the town of Albion.*

Where You Come In: *We encourage you to review the project information and provide comments regarding project alternatives.*

Project Need and Proposed Design Features: *The project is needed because both bridges are reaching the end of their service life. Design features include separated walkways to accommodate pedestrians on both bridges and wider shoulders to improve vehicle and bicycle safety.*
