Special Event South Of Garberville Expected To Cause Traffic Congestion In Humboldt, Lake, and Mendocino Counties

French's Camp, adjacent to Route 101, approximately 10 miles south of Garberville, near the Humboldt-Mendocino County Line, will be the site for the Reggae Rising concert. The event will begin Friday, August 3, and will end Sunday, August 5. Traffic delays may occur as far south as Willits on Route 101 and along Route 20 from Interstate 5 to Route 101 beginning Thursday, August 2. Those traveling through the area may experience short delays. Up to one-hour delays are expected at the conclusion of the event and into Monday, August 6. The one-hour delays will most likely occur at the event location, on two-lane highway segments, and southbound near the City of Willits. Also, only local traffic will be allowed on Route 271 Thursday through Monday.

People Productions of Redway has been granted a Caltrans encroachment permit to install temporary traffic control features on Route 101 to alert the traveling public to temporary traffic congestion caused by the special event. The California Highway Patrol and event volunteers will be providing traffic control near the event area.
