FORT BRAGG TURN LANES SAFETY PROJECT UPDATE

Eureka – Work on the Fort Bragg Turn Lanes Safety Project on Route 20 near the City of Fort Bragg in Mendocino County, which is currently in winter suspension, is scheduled to resume early June, 2009. The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate about 2.1 miles of highway from South Harbor Drive to Gravel Pit Road, improve the roadside drainage system, and add left turn lanes and bike lanes.

The project is close to completion, with only the final paving and striping remaining. The highway was temporarily striped for the winter after cooling weather caused the final paving to be suspended until late spring. The temporary striping does not include the left turn lanes which will be added during the final striping.

This \$5 million safety project is anticipated to be completed by mid-summer 2009. The contractor is Argonaut Constructors of Santa Rosa.
