### **CALTRANS RESCHEDULES 24 HOUR TRAFFIC CONTROL AT THE CONFUSION HILL REALIGNMENT PROJECT ON ROUTE 101**

**Eureka** – Caltrans announced today that the 24 hour traffic control originally scheduled for May 4 through May 8 has been rescheduled due to rainy weather.

Beginning at 6AM on Monday, May 11, and continuing through 3PM on Friday, May 15, one-way traffic control using a pilot car will be in effect 24 hours per day at the Confusion Hill Realignment project on Route 101, located about 9 miles north of Leggett in Mendocino County. Motorists should anticipate 10-minute delays.

This traffic control is required to allow for paving at the south end of the project near a new retaining wall. The 24 hour traffic control will allow the work to be completed as quickly as possible, resulting in minimal impact to the traveling public. It is anticipated two more short periods of 24 hour per day one-way traffic control will be required to complete paving, and future updates will provide details.
