PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PROJECT TO BEGIN ON ROUTE 101 IN WILLITS

EUREKA – Caltrans announced today that a crosswalk safety enhancement project on Route 101 (South Main Street) at Gregory Lane in Willits is anticipated to begin July 30. The project was awarded to Cal Electro, Incorporated, of Redding for \$118,965. Work will include pedestrian activated in-road lighting and a median island to provide pedestrians a refuge while crossing the four lanes of Route 101. The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of August.

Work hours will be 6AM to 4:30PM, weekdays. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction of travel from 6AM to noon. Motorists may experience minor traffic slowdowns.
