





EAST SONORA



Bypass Project Stage II State Route 108



The California Department of Transportation, in conjunction with the Tuolumne County Transportation Council (TCTC), will construct a two lane expressway on a new alignment from Peaceful Oak Road to Via Este Road.

This \$52.9 million project will be built as a continuation of the East Sonora Bypass Stage I, which was completed in 2002.

This project is aided by the 2006 voter-approved transportation bond, Proposition 1B, which provided \$14.53 million. The project will:

- Ease congestion
- Improve mobility
- Decrease travel times for all motorists
- Fix operational problems on the current highway alignment
- And enhance safety for both commuters and recreational traffic.

A partial interchange at Peaceful Oak Road, a grade separation at Mono Way and a temporary at-grade "T" intersection connecting Mono Way to the new expressway will also be built. In addition, a frontage road connecting existing SR-108 with both Seaborn Road and Waif Road will be constructed.

Construction began on April 19, 2012 and is expected to be completed July 2014.
