



Interstate 205 Stage II, Stage III and Stage IV



Work Continuing on Interstate 205

Work continues to take place between Eleventh Street and Grant Line Road and between the eastbound Tracy Boulevard Ramp and the Mac Arthur Drive off-ramp. Workers have already constructed two eastbound soundwalls and will extend auxiliary lanes at the Eleventh Street on-ramp. During this time, the contractor will continue working on Stage II, Stage III and Stage IV of the project. Stage III work will consist of replacing existing concrete pavement and place an asphalt concrete overlay along the entire project. The contractors on this \$92 million project are O.C. Jones and Sons Inc. of Berkeley, California and C. C. Myers of Rancho Cordova, California as a Joint Venture. This project is scheduled to be completed in late Spring 2010. Interstate-205 Construction Schedule

Stage 1

This phase consisted of work on Interstate 205 between Eleventh Street and Grant Line Road and between the eastbound Tracy Boulevard on-ramp and the Mac Arthur Drive off-ramp.

*Construct Soundwalls (2 eastbound Locations) **Completed**
Extend Auxiliary Lane at Eleventh Street on-ramp **Completed***

Stage 2

This phase will consist of work on Interstate 205 between Eleventh Street and Interstate 5.

*Replace Existing Concrete Pavement **In Progress - 90 Percent Completed**
Place Asphalt Concrete Overlay **Completed***

Stage 3

Some of this work may be completed in conjunction with Stage 1. This phase will consist of work on Interstate 205 between Eleventh Street and Interstate 5.

*Begin Bridge Widening (Piles and Columns) **In Progress - 45 Percent Completed**
Widen Eastbound Interstate 205 Bridge over Interstate 5 **In Progress - 20 Percent Completed***

Stage 4

This phase will consist of work on Interstate 205 between Eleventh Street and Interstate 5.

*Complete Bridge Widening **In Progress - 25 Percent Completed**
Construct New Lanes (In Median) **In Progress - 20 Percent Completed.***

Stage 5

This phase will consist of work on Interstate 205 between Eleventh Street and Interstate 5.

*Complete Asphalt Construction Overlay **Work to begin Fall 2009**
Complete Final Roadway Work **Work to begin Fall 2009***

Motorists are reminded that speeds are reduced in construction zones. The reduction of the speed limit is necessary for the safety of the motorist, as well as for the safety of construction crews. The California Highway Patrol is normally onsite to enforce the reduced speed limit and you are subject to double the fines for exceeding the speed limit in construction zones. The California Department of Transportation wants you to return home and to your family safely. Motorists can make

trips a little safer by remembering the following work zone safety tips:

- Do not speed in work zones; obey the posted speed limits;
- Stay Alert! Expect the unexpected;
- Watch for workers; drive with caution;
- Don't change lanes unnecessarily;
- Avoid using mobile phones while driving in work zones;

- Turn on headlights so workers and other drivers can see you;
- Be especially alert while driving in work zones at night;
- Expect delays; especially during peak travel times;
- Allow ample space between you and the car in front of you;
- Anticipate lane shifts, and merge when directed to do so.
