


# NORTH COUNTY CORRIDOR PROJECT, STANISLAUS COUNTY, CALIFORNIA ALTERNATIVE INFORMATION SHEET



## ALTERNATIVE 9C – LADD/PATTERSON/ ROUTE 108

**Length:** 20.9 miles

**Cost:** \$1.028 billion

**Purpose and Need:** This alternative does not meet project Purpose and Need because it bypasses the city of Modesto and would not economically benefit the city.

**Relocations/Acreage:** 850 parcels, 628 building structures which include 388 commercial buildings, 333 urban acres, and 427 rural acres would be affected.

**Excessive Construction Cost:** This alternative would not result in excessive construction cost because total construction cost would be \$720 million, which is less than \$1.2 billion identified in the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan.

**Severe Operational or Safety Problems:** The existing density of adjacent development could result in operational and safety problems.

**Unacceptable Adverse Social, Economic, or Environmental Impacts:** This alternative would disrupt and divide an existing community and result in economic and social impacts to residents and businesses.

**Combination of Reasons which taken Individually may not be Significant but Would be Significant Cumulatively:** Cumulative impacts would result due to relocations, operational or safety problems, and social, economic, and environmental impacts.

**Previously Rejected at an Earlier Stage in the Planning Process:** No

**Recommendation:** This alternative is not recommended for future consideration because it does not satisfy all of the screening criteria. This alternative would require a high number of relocations and parcel acquisition, have high economic, social impacts, and cumulative impacts. In addition, it does not meet the Purpose and Need because it would not economically benefit the city of Modesto as it bypasses the city.
