

ALTERNATIVE 10C-3 – HAMMETT/LADD TO ALTERNATIVE 10C

Length: 24.4 miles

Cost: \$817 million

Purpose and Need: This alternative meets project Purpose and Need.

Relocations/Acreage: 258 parcels, 60 building structures which include 20 commercial buildings, 286 urban acres, and 628 rural acres would be affected.

Excessive Construction Cost: This alternative would not result in excessive construction cost because total construction cost would be \$734 million, which is less than \$1.2 billion identified in the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan.

Severe Operational or Safety Problems: The existing density of adjacent development could result in operational and safety problems.

Unacceptable Adverse Social, Economic, or Environmental Impacts: This alternative would disrupt and divide an existing community and result in economic and social impacts to residents and businesses. Additionally, it would have high impacts to rural acreage.

Combination of Reasons which taken Individually may not be Significant but Would be Significant Cumulatively: Cumulative impacts would result due to relocations, operational and safety problems, social, economic, and environmental impacts.

Previously Rejected at an Earlier Stage in the Planning Process: No

Recommendation: This alternative is not recommended for future consideration because it does not satisfy all screening criteria. This alternative has high economic and social impacts, high impacts to rural acreage, and cumulative impacts to the community as a result of economic impacts.
