


NORTH COUNTY CORRIDOR PROJECT, STANISLAUS COUNTY, CALIFORNIA ALTERNATIVE INFORMATION SHEET



ALTERNATIVE 14 – KIERNAN/CLAUS/SR 108

Length: 21.0 miles

Cost: \$787 Million

Purpose and Need: This alternative meets project Purpose and Need.

Relocations/Acreage: 822 parcels, 670 building structures which include 20 commercial buildings, 466 urban acres, and 382 rural acres would be affected.

Excessive Construction Cost: This alternative would not result in excessive construction cost because total construction cost would be \$670 million dollars, which is less than \$1.2 billion identified in the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan.

Severe Operational or Safety Problems: The existing density of adjacent development could result in operational and safety problems.

Unacceptable Adverse Social, Economic, or Environmental Impacts: This alternative would disrupt and divide an existing community and result in economic and social impacts to residents and businesses.

Combination of Reasons which taken Individually may not be Significant but Would be Significant Cumulatively: Cumulative impacts would result due to relocations, operational or safety problems, and social, economic, and environmental impacts.

Previously Rejected at an Earlier Stage in the Planning Process: No

Recommendation: This alternative is not recommended for future consideration because it does not satisfy all of the screening criteria. This alternative has excessive relocations and parcels affected, high economic and social impacts, and cumulative impacts to the community as a result of relocations and economic impacts.
