

Announcement of Public Information Meeting/Open House

For the State Route 12 Operational Improvements Project In San Joaquin County on Route 12 Between Potato Slough Bridge and I-5; In Solano County and Sacramento County on Route 12

WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

Caltrans is proposing a series of operational improvements at key intersections combined with Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) elements to optimize the traffic flow conditions and enhance travel safety, efficiency and mobility on the SR 12 corridor and on I-5.

The proposed operational improvements include:

- Realigning Tower Parkway under the Potato Slough Bridge to connect with Glasscock Road
- Adding a westbound left turn lane at Correia Road
- Adding eastbound acceleration lanes at Tower Parkway and Guard Road and extending existing left and right turn lanes at Guard Road
- Providing a bus turnout on westbound access west of Glasscock Road and extending the existing westbound Route 12 lane drop
- Adding Intelligence Traffic Systems (ITS) warning and guide signs at several locations
- Increasing the existing 0.5 acre park and ride lot east of I-5 to 2 acres

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE ?

Caltrans is currently performing the environmental studies for the preliminary design for the SR 12 Operational Improvements Project. The Public Information Meeting/Open House will give you an opportunity to learn more about the project and to provide input. The tentative project schedule will be presented, including environmental studies, project design, construction, and the purchase of land for right of way.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

Preliminary design plans and other displays explaining the project development process will be available for viewing. Caltrans staff specialists in engineering, environmental planning, and right-of-way will be available to discuss your concerns and answer your questions. No formal presentation will be made. Please come by between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.
