


State Route 12

MOKELUMNE RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

(San Joaquin County)



The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is preparing to construct a project on State Route 12 (SR-12) at the Mokelumne River Bridge (a Swing-Truss Drawbridge constructed in 1942) at the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line.

- **Stage 1 - Bridge Deck Replacement (March - November 2015)**
Replaces the existing aging concrete bridge deck with cast in place concrete.
- **Stage 2 - Control House Rehabilitation (March - November 2015)**
Removes and replaces the existing electrical elements and modifies the beams below the control house providing six inches to nine inches of additional clearance for trucks.

How This Will Affect The Travelling Public

Because the majority of the work being done is above or under the travel way, some full closures of bridge are necessary to ensure the safety of both workers and motorists. Caltrans will close the highway and bridge for 6 weekends, from 10:00 p.m. on Fridays to 5:00 a.m. Mondays.

- **Install protective cover and bird control measures:** ■ February 2 - 13, 2015 (No traffic impact)
- **One way traffic control:** ■ March 2, 2015 - May 29, 2015
- **Two 55 hour weekend closures:** ■ March 6 - 9, 2015 ■ April 10 - 13, 2015
- **Four 55 hour weekend closures:** ■ October 23 - 26, 2015 ■ October 30 - November 2, 2015
■ November 6 - 9, 2015 ■ November 13 - 16, 2015

Anticipated Project Completion Date: November 2015


The bridge is closed to large marine vessels March 2 - June 26, 2015. Detours will be posted. Motorists should consider Interstate 80 (I-80), I-5 and SR-4 as alternate routes and should allow additional travel time due to the detour. The signed detour for the area will be SR-160 north to Walnut Grove Road, then to I-5 (a 30-mile/45-minute detour).

Current truck restrictions apply. CA LEGAL with kingpin to rear axle over 30 feet are not recommended on SR-160. Trucks are encouraged to use I-5 and I-80 as an alternate route. The amount of days for full closure has been minimized to include only the work required. Other work will be done by one-way traffic control.

This construction season window is given by United States Coast Guard to accommodate Marine traffic during summer season. **Construction is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/ or materials and construction related issues.**
