The first of eight, 55-hour weekend closures proceeded as scheduled on Friday 04/29/16. The westbound State Route 4 (SR-4) Crosstown Freeway was closed at the northbound and southbound connector ramps at SR-99 at 10:00 p.m. on Friday. The #3 lane between the Filbert on-ramp and Stanislaus off-ramp was, however, open to traffic.

Bridge removal activities began right after the closures were implemented and were followed by installation of bearing assemblies, rebar installation,

concrete pour, and joint seal assembly installation. Our maintenance crew was out during the day-time hours of Saturday and Sunday doing crack sealing work.

Traffic congestion was observed only during the hours of 11 am – 1 pm and 5 pm – 7 pm. The maximum delay was 4 minutes. Traffic conditions along detour routes were normal, no delays. Our next weekend closure will take place May 20 - May 23.


