




# What is the Project Purpose and Need?

The existing segment of State Route 4 between Copperopolis and Angels Camp consists of a non-engineered roadway alignment with no shoulders alongside the State Route. The roadway follows the existing rolling hills, resulting in numerous curves and limited vision for drivers, which reduces the operating speed of the roadway to approximately 25 to 35 miles per hour.

In order to reduce accidents, improve traffic flow, as well as to “close the gap” between improved roadway segments, the Calaveras County Department of Public Works, in coordination with Caltrans, is proposing to realign this segment of roadway in accordance with current design standards.






