# CANCELLED

## FULL HIGHWAY CLOSURE

### STATE ROUTE 4 FROM THE SAN JOAQUIN/CONTRA COSTA COUNTY LINE TO ROBERTS ISLAND ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will install rumble strip on State Route 4 (SR-4) from the San Joaquin/Contra Costa County line to Roberts Island Road. Work will occur as follows:

- SR-4 from Tracy Boulevard to Roberts Island Road will close beginning Wednesday, April 13, 2011, at 8:00 p.m. until Thursday, April 14, 2011, at 5:00 a.m. and
- SR-4 from Tracy Boulevard to the San Joaquin/Contra Costa County line at the Old River Bridge will close beginning Thursday, April 14, 2011, at 8:00 p.m. until Friday, April 15, 2011, at 5:00 a.m.

The detour for Wednesday night is:

- Eastbound:
  - SR-4 to southbound Tracy Boulevard
  - South on Tracy Boulevard to Howard Road
  - East on Howard Road to Roberts Road
  - North on Roberts Road to SR-4
- Westbound:
  - SR-4 to southbound Roberts Road
  - South on Roberts Road to Howard Road
  - West on Howard Road to Tracy Boulevard
  - North on Tracy Boulevard to SR-4

The detour for Thursday night is:

- Eastbound:
  - SR-4 to Byron Highway
  - South on Byron Highway to Grant Line Road
  - East on Grant Line Road to Interstate 205 (I-205)
  - East on I-205 to Tracy Boulevard
  - North on Tracy Boulevard to SR-4
- Westbound:
  - SR-4 to Tracy Boulevard
  - South on Tracy Boulevard to I-205
  - West on I-205 to Grant Line Road exit
  - West on Naglee Road to Grant Line Road
  - West on Grant Line Road to Byron Highway
  - North on Byron Highway to SR-4

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change based on weather conditions.
