### **TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM HAMMER LANE TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/SACRAMENTO COUNTY LINE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will replace slabs on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Hammer Lane to San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive on or off-ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The # 3 (right) lane on northbound I-5 from Hammer Lane to Eight Mile Road will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, at 6:00 p.m. through Monday, August 22, 2011, at 6:00 a.m.;
- The # 3 (right) lane on northbound I-5 from Eight Mile Road to State Route 12 (SR-12) will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on northbound I-5 from SR-12 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound on and off-ramps between Hammer Lane and Walnut Grove Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, at 9:00 p.m. through Monday, August 22, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on southbound I-5 from SR-12 to Hammer Lane will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The southbound on and off-ramps between Hammer Lane and Walnut Grove Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.; and

- The #2 (right) lane on southbound I-5 from the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line to SR-12 will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change based on weather conditions.
