TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 26/FREMONT STREET TO WOODBRIDGE ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will treat the bridge decks on State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-26/Fremont Street to Woodbridge Road. No two consecutive on or off-ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound off-ramp and the southbound on-ramp at SR-26/Fremont Street will close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on eastbound and westbound SR-26/Fremont Street at SR-99 will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp at Turner Road and the southbound on-ramp from Woodbridge Road will close beginning Sunday August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.; and
- The left shoulder, #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on southbound SR-99 at the Mokelumne River will alternately close beginning Sunday August 21, 2011, through Friday, August 26, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.
