TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM HAMMER LANE TO THE SAN JOAQUIN/SACRAMENTO COUNTY LINE IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

San Joaquin County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will replace slabs on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Hammer Lane to San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive on or off-ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The # 1 (left) and #2 (right) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from Hammer Lane to Eight Mile Road will close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 6:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The # 1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from Eight Mile Road to State Route 12 (SR-12) will close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on northbound I-5 from SR-12 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (right) lane on southbound I-5 from SR-12 to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps between Hammer Lane and Walnut Grove Road will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.; and
- The connector ramps from northbound and southbound I-5 to SR-12 will alternately close beginning Sunday, August 28, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
