TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 NEAR STOCKTON

San Joaquin County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will work to widen bridges, repair the pavement, stripe the roadway and replace slabs on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard/Charter Way to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #4 (right) lane from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard/Charter Way to the Anderson Street undercrossing and the on-ramp from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard/Charter Way on northbound I-5 will close beginning Tuesday, December 13, 2011, through Wednesday, December 14, 2011, from 8:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from the Stockton Channel to March Lane will alternately close beginning Sunday, December 11, 2011, through Friday, December 16, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 between Country Club Boulevard and March Lane will alternately close beginning Monday, December 12, 2011, through Thursday, December 15, 2011, from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.;
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 between Benjamin Holt Drive and the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, December 11, 2011, through Friday, December 16, 2011, from 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.;
- The #3 (right) lane on northbound and southbound I-5 from Eight Mile Road to SR-12 will close beginning Monday, December 12, 2011, through Friday, December 16, 2011, from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.; and

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound I-5 from Benjamin Holt Drive to the San Joaquin/Sacramento County line will alternately close beginning Sunday, December 11, 2011, through Friday, December 16, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 20 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
