### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 FROM STATE ROUTE 26/FREMONT STREET TO WOODBRIDGE ROAD IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

**San Joaquin County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will treat the bridge decks on State Route 99 (SR-99) from SR-26/Fremont Street to Woodbridge Road. No two consecutive on or off-ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur as follows:

- The northbound off-ramp and the southbound on-ramp at SR-26/Fremont Street will close beginning Sunday, July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane on eastbound and westbound SR-26/Fremont Street at SR-99 beginning Sunday, July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on-ramps from SR-88/Waterloo Road to SR-99 will close beginning Sunday, July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- Crews will perform one-way traffic control on SR-88/Waterloo Road at SR-99 beginning Sunday, July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The southbound off-ramp at Turner Road will close beginning Sunday July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on southbound SR-99 at the Mokelumne River will alternately close beginning Sunday July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;

- The southbound on-ramp at Woodbridge Road will close beginning Sunday July 24, 2011, through Friday, July 29, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.; and
- The left shoulder and #1 (left) lane on northbound SR-99 from Armstrong Road to Harney Lane will close on Monday, July 25, 2011, from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change based on weather conditions.
