TRAFFIC ADVISORY NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 FROM MITCHELL ROAD TO THE STANISLAUS/SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY LINE IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will replace slabs on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Mitchell Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. Work will occur as follows:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes on northbound SR-99 from Mitchell Road to Hatch Road will close beginning Sunday, May 8, 2011, at 9:00 p.m. until Monday, May 9, 2011, at 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound SR-99 from Tuolumne Boulevard to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line will close beginning Tuesday, May 10, 2011, through Thursday, May 12, 2011, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.; and
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound SR-99 from Hammett Road to the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line will close beginning Monday, May 9, 2011, at 9:00 p.m. until Tuesday, May 10, 2011, at 5:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change based on weather conditions.
