### TRAFFIC ADVISORY

#### STATE ROUTE 99 FROM THE JUNCTION OF STATE ROUTE 219 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY TO STATE ROUTE 120 IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

**San Joaquin/Stanislaus County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will construct a median barrier and perform pavement work on State Route 99 (SR-99) in Stanislaus County from the junction of State Route 219 (SR-219) to State Route 120 in San Joaquin County. No two consecutive on or off-ramps will be closed at the same time. Lane restrictions are as follows:

Various full on and off-ramps from Milgeo Avenue to SR-120 will close beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2011, through Wednesday, September 7, 2011, from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m., and

#### Southbound:

- The median, left shoulder, #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes from Milgeo Avenue to Hammett Road will close beginning Monday, August 29, 2011, through Friday, September 2, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.; and
- The left shoulder, #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes from SR-120 to Milgeo Avenue will alternately close beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2011, through Friday, September 9, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., and

#### Northbound:

- The median, left shoulder, #1 (left) and #2 (middle) lanes from the junction of SR-219 to Milgeo Avenue will close beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2011, through Friday, September 9, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.; and
- The left shoulder, #1 (left), #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes from Milgeo Avenue to SR-120 will alternately close beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2011, through Friday, September 9, 2011, from 7:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
