TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 FROM THE CHANNEL VIADUCT TO THE CALAVERAS RIVER IN STOCKTON

Stockton- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform routine maintenance and begin work to widen the bridges on Interstate 5 (I-5) from the Channel Viaduct to the Calaveras River. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The #1 (left) and #2 (middle left) lanes on northbound I-5 from the Channel Viaduct to Michigan Avenue will close on Sunday, September 11, 2011, from 3:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon);
- The #1 (left) lane on northbound and southbound I-5 from Monte Diablo Avenue to Alpine Avenue will close beginning Sunday, September 11, 2011, through Friday, September 16, 2011, from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. and #2 (middle) lane will also close from 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (middle) and #3 (right) lanes on northbound I-5 from Country Club Boulevard to the Calaveras River will close on Saturday, September 17, 2011, from 3:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon); and
- The northbound on-ramp from Alpine Avenue will close on Saturday, September 17, 2011, from 3:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon).

Motorists should expect 10 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
