### TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

**Stanislaus County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from Taylor Road to Hammett Road. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hammett Road will alternately close beginning Monday, December 17, 2012, through Saturday, December 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 a.m.;
- The #2 (center) and #3 (right) lanes and right shoulder on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Taylor Road to Hammett Road will close beginning Monday, December 17, 2012, through Saturday, December 22, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 30 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials and construction related issues.
