### TRAFFIC ADVISORY INTERSTATE 5 NEAR STOCKTON

**Stockton** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will work to place k-rail, perform routine bridge maintenance and other miscellaneous maintenance work on Interstate 5 (I-5) from State Route 4 (SR-4)/Crosstown Freeway to Hammer Lane. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The connector ramps from SR-4 to I-5 will close beginning Monday, February 6, 2012, through Friday, February 10, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The northbound and southbound on and off-ramps at Pershing Avenue/Fremont Street will alternately close beginning Monday, February 6, 2012 through Friday, February 10, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane on northbound and southbound I-5 from Charter Way to Country Club Boulevard will close beginning Monday, February 6, 2012, through Friday, February 10, 2012, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.; and
- The lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 from SR-4 to Hammer Lane will alternately close beginning Monday, February 6, 2012, through Friday, February 10, 2012, from 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Motorists should expect 15 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
