TRAFFIC ADVISORY STATE ROUTE 99 IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

Stanislaus County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform highway construction on State Route 99 (SR-99) from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County Line to the Stanislaus/ Merced County Line. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time. Work will occur at the following locations:

- The lanes on northbound and southbound SR-99 from the Stanislaus/ San Joaquin County Line to the Stanislaus/ Merced County Line will alternately close beginning Monday, June 11, 2012, through Saturday, June 16, 2012, from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.;
- The on and off-ramps on northbound and southbound SR-99 will alternately close beginning Monday, June 11, 2012, through Friday, June 15, 2012, from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Hatch Road to SR-132 (Maze Boulevard/ L Street) will close beginning Monday, June 11, 2012, through Wednesday, June 13, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.;
- The #1 (left) lane and median on northbound and southbound SR-99 from Pelandale Avenue to Hammett Road will close on Thursday, June 14, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Motorists should expect 25 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change.
