### **FULL HIGHWAY CLOSURE STATE ROUTE 49 FROM SILVA ROAD/ INDIAN PEAK ROAD TO ALLRED ROAD IN MARIPOSA COUNTY**

**Mariposa County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform one-way traffic control on State Route 49 from Silva Road/ Indian Peak Road to Allred Road for roadway excavation.

Work will begin on Monday, May 21, 2012, through Friday, May 25, 2012, from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Motorists should expect 15 minute delays.

Crews will also intermittently close the highway on Tuesday, May 22, 2012, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for blasting. This work was originally set for Monday, May 21, 2012 but has been rescheduled.

Motorists should expect 30 to 60 minute delays. Alternate routes should be taken whenever possible.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change based on weather conditions.
